

## SSU-Secure Wi-Fi Access Mac OSX

1. Open the wireless menu in top right corner and ensure that Wi-Fi is turned on



2. Once you are connected to Wi-Fi, select the SSU-Secure network



3. You will be prompted to enter your credentials. Leave the mode set to "Automatic" and enter your SeawolfID and password. \*\*Remember that your SeawolfID is not your entire email, just the username

9. In the Wi-Fi advanced menu, make sure you are in the "Wi-Fi" tab. Highlight the SSU-Secure network under Preferred Networks. Click the minus button underneath Preferred Networks. You have now successfully removed the SSU-Secure network. Click OK to finish.
